#01

PROJECTS MUST COME FROM THE PEOPLE OF CALVARY.

The leadership of Calvary has been tasked by the board to oversee certain area of responsibility therefore making it a challenge to take on other initiative. Therefore, the initiative must not involve staff members.

#03

THE INITIATIVE MUST BE SELF SUSTAINING (IF REOCCURRING).

Upon approval by the Lead Pastor, Calvary may help with some launching costs, but the resources needed for the initiative must not be funded by Calvary Church. If the event is a one-time initiative, it is intended that resources are gathered from other sources in addition to Calvary Church.

#02

THERE MUST BE A TEAM WORKING TOGETHER.

Jesus sent out the disciples in groups of two or more. He did so for accountability and support. Whether it is two people or a team of twenty, the initiative must involve more than one person.

THE INITIATIVE MUST ADHERE TO OUR STATEMENT OF FAITH.
