What will a Sunday Morning
Service look like on-campus?



From arrival to departure. Here is a look at what to expect on a Sunday Morning.

Friendly Parking Lot Attendants will help direct traffic. Only Parking Lots C & D will be available.

After parking, you will enter a "social distanced" line outside the South East Entrance (Info Center doors).

This will be the only entrance into the building.



While in line, volunteers will check your name off the RSVP list.

One-by-one each family, couple, or individual will be guided into the church building.

Upon entering the building, you will be asked to use hand sanitizer and be provided a mask if you do not have one.

You will then be asked a couple of screening questions. If you answer yes to any of the questions you will be asked to return home.



After you have been screened, attendance will be taken by a volunteer.

If you have children with you, you can pick up a pre-packaged kit off of Miss Barbs table for each child to help them stay engaged through the service.

Now you are ready to follow the markers and make your way into the auditorium.



Once inside the auditorium, ushers will help guide and seat you in our new social- distanced auditorium.

You will then join the rest of Calvary Church by watching the Sunday morning online gathering.

Following the teaching portion, you will be provided breakout questions that you can discuss with who is seated near you, or reflect individually.

After the service is over you will exit the building following the markers.

What are the screening questions ?






For the most part—yes. The pre-recorded service will be played in the auditorium. The only difference will be the option to join a social-distanced break-out session with those seated near you in the auditorium.

During our service at the time of musical worship, there will be no singing. Instead we are encouraging a moment of reflective prayer during this time.
